Senior Dine is a restaurant based meal program operated by Senior Nutrition Services of New Opportunities, Inc. The program is available to area residents aged 60 or over. There is no income eligibility requirement to join.



For a per meal suggested donation of \$3.50—\$5.00, registered participants can dine at area restaurants. Senior Dine offers more flexible schedules and meal choices than traditional Senior Community Cafes. Senior Dine works with local restaurants to develop menus that are affordable and healthy.

Senior Dine promotes socialization and independence while catering to your nutritional needs.

## Registration & Using the Card is Easy

- The initial registration for Senior Dine must be done in person.
- Contact Senior Nutrition Services at 203.757.7738 to schedule an appointment or visit us online at [www.NewOpplnc.org](http://www.NewOpplnc.org) for other registration locations in your area.
- During registration, you will complete a brief intake form. You will submit an order form and provide your first donation based on the number of meals you would like.
- A card will be provided to you immediately and can be used within 24 hours.
- All future meal orders can be placed via mail or in person. It will take approximately 5 days for mailed orders to be reflected on your card.
- You can use your card at any participating location during their Senior Dine hours
- Present your card to your server prior to ordering. Your server will provide you with a Senior Dine Menu. No substitutions or take-outs available.
- Your server will swipe your card and present you with the receipt. The receipt will indicate how many credits you have remaining on your card.
- Once you are down to “2 Credits”, the receipt will indicate “recharge” to remind you to order more meals on your card.
- The suggested donation per meal is **\$3.50—\$5.00**. Actual value of most meals is **\$10.00**.
- Please remember to tip your server based on the full-value of the meal!
